I have been contacted by a number of homeowners concerning issues they may have with the dispatch service at the Constables office. I forward all to Captain Cannon for his review. I received an email from him the other day which speaks to the process. I am hopeful that this information will help to alleviate some of the issues that have existed concerning this problem.

Please remember that the call takers/dispatchers may not know the address of every institution in our area so they will need help to locate the problem and get there as soon as possible. Perhaps an area map of Oakwood Glen to every resident would be helpful, it would show cross streets and the location of the common areas and any institutions in this area.

I will work on producing one that is usable and make them available online, hopefully at the website and at the monthly board meetings. Watch the website for the inclusion of this map.

1. The dispatch number (like all other police dispatch numbers) does not reach any specific deputy; it goes directly to the communications center of the Harris County Constable's Office Precinct 4
2. Callers are answered by a call taker or dispatcher. There are no deputies in the dispatch center
3. The call taker or dispatcher does not have the ability to connect a caller with any specific deputy.
4. The function of the call taker is;

To get the name, address and telephone number of the caller

To determine the nature of the problem

To obtain the location of the problem

To enter this information in to the computer aided dispatch system.

5. The radio dispatcher's main job is to broadcast the nature and location of calls holding.
6. Calls are assigned to the nearest available deputy in order to keep response time at a minimum.
7. Calls in any subdivision are answered by the contract deputy the majority of the time, but no 100% of the time (they might already be on a call when another one is broadcast). If the deputy is off duty or busy on another call, a district deputy or deputy in a nearby contract will take the unanswered call.
8. In the absence of a contract deputy due to days off, District deputies or deputies in other contracts respond to calls in the contract as a matter of courtesy and con-

We have a library located nearby, go down Stuebner-Airline to Cypress Creek Dr, turn East and go the first light, look to you right and there it is. The church there also has many evening hour activities for kids that are chaperoned and safe.

Hurricane season is moving into the critical time. Katrina was around October of last year so don't let you guard down because we have had none so far this year. Make sure you have bottled water and food to last your family for at least 4 days, put all your important papers in secure containers; make sure if you evacuate that you take all of your medications with you; secure your home; take care of your pets; check on your neighbors to see if they are ok. 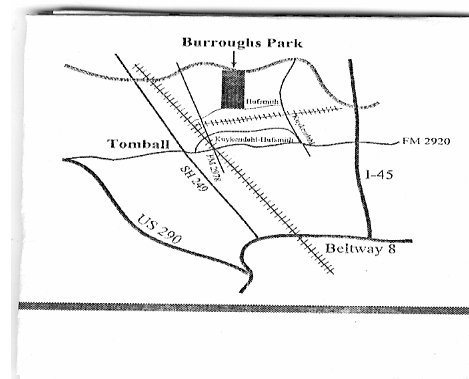

Restrictions filed under Harris County Clerk's File No. E624197; Article VII, Section 15.; states "No trucks, trailers, boats, or any vehicle other than passenger cares will be permitted to park on streets on drives in front of residence for longer that a forty-eight (48) hour period."

Restrictions filed under Harris County Clerk's File No. F395956; Article VIII, Section 7, part (d) states "No truck, bus, motor home, boat or trailer shall be left parked in or on the street adjacent to any lot, or in the driveway or on any other portion or any such Lot exposed to public view (except for construction or repair equipment, only while a house or houses are being built or repaired in the immediate vicinity), unless such vehicle is in day-to-day use off the premises and such parking is only temporary, from day-to-day; provided however, that nothing herein contained shall be construed to prohibit the storage of an unused vehicle in an enclosed garage on an Lot."

FOR INFORMATION ON THE PETITION TO BAN COMMERCIAL VEHICLES FROM OVERNIGHT PARKING, FROM 10 PM UNTIL 6AM, PURSUANT TO TEX. TRANSP.CODE ANN. 522.003 (VERNON 1997), SAME CONTAINS A DEFINITION OF A COMMERCIAL VEHICLE.
